Quick Start Guide

Requirements

In order to run Indexu 7, the server must have the following softwares installed.

- Apache web server with mod-rewrite module enabled
- PHP 5.2
- PHP modules:
 - GD
 - CURL
- MYSQL 5

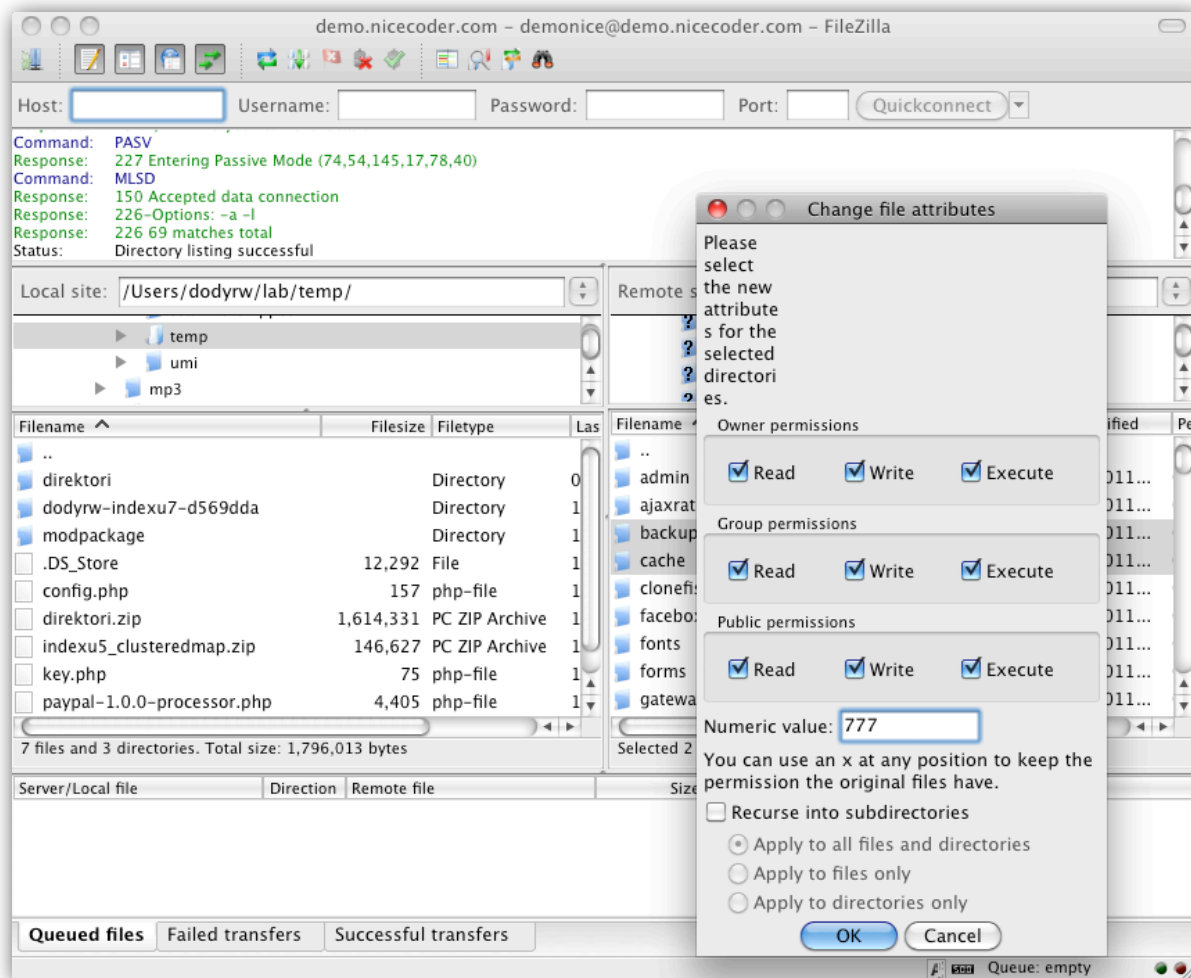
Installation

Follow the step by step below to install Indexu 7.

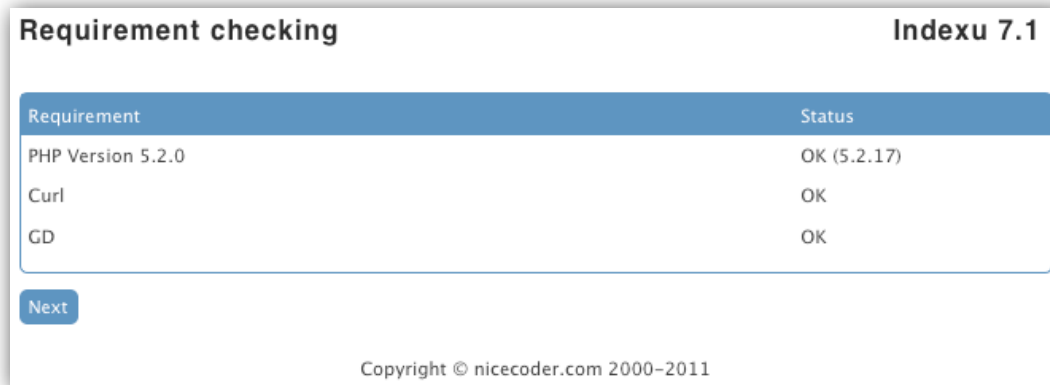
- 1) Unzip indexu file.
- 2) Edit `config.php`, fill with mysql information.

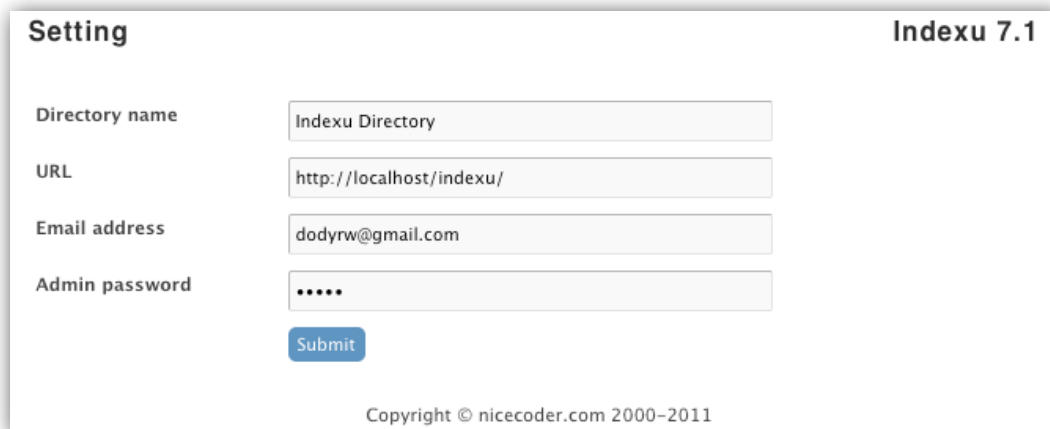
- 3) Upload all files to server.
- 4) `CHMOD 777` the following folders: `backup`, `cache`, `templates`, `upload` and `sitemap`.



5) Run install script with the browser and follow the instruction (www.domain.tld/install/install.php).



6) If you do fresh installation, you will need to fill directory name, url, email address and admin password. The default admin user is **admin**. You will need this admin username to login into admin panel to manage the directory.



7) If you are upgrading from previous Indexu 7 version, the install script will auto detect previous version and do database modification.

8) After installation completed. Remove the **install** folder.

9) Before login into admin panel, you need to enter your license key. The license key is obtained from nicecoder client area. To edit the license key, edit **key.php** file.



Post Installation

Now you should have Indexu 7 running in your server. Here are some additional steps to get your directory up and running quickly.

1) Change the admin password.

Admin Panel > Users > Manage > Edit 'admin' user

3) Set paypal payment.



Cron Job

Set the cron job to run the script daily.

0 0 * * * php -q /home/indexufolder/cron.php
```

This script will do :

- 1) Email to admin for banner ads expire (daily)
- 2) Check broken link (once per week for each link)
- 3) Check reciprocal link (once per week for each link)
